










Recreational Activities

-  Two boat-launching ramps are available at the marina. Overnight docking rental is available through the concession. Stays are limited to two weeks.
-  Food, limited grocery items, snorkel boat tours and kayak rentals are available at the concession building. Daily beach rentals and snorkeling equipment can be obtained at the dive shop.
-  Tarpon fishing in the area rates among the best in the state. Grouper, snapper and grunts also may be caught, among many other species. Saltwater fishing laws are enforced (check local laws).
-  Pets must be confined, kept on a 6-foot hand-held leash or under the physical control of a person. Tethered pets must not be left unattended for more than 30 minutes. Pet owners must pick up after their pets and properly dispose of all pet droppings in trash receptacles.
-   Swimming is available in the Atlantic Ocean and Florida Bay. Swimming is prohibited in marinas and boat channels. A diver's down flag is required for snorkelers.
-  Beach wheelchairs are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Request should be made at the ranger station.

Camping Information

-  Three duplex cabins (six units) provide accommodations for six people per cabin. Cabin #2 is wheelchair accessible and accommodates four people.
-  There are three separate campgrounds. Stays are limited to two weeks at a time. A dump station is provided in Buttonwood.
 1. No camper mail will be accepted.
 2. Alcohol is not permitted except in overnight accommodations areas.
 3. We are a "Campground Host" park. If you are interested in volunteering, please inquire at the ranger station.
